5.01:	Public Forum: Concern was expressed regarding the footpath that runs across Valley Farm. Walkers are making a diversion around the stile as it is difficult to cross. Dogs are running loose into the barns and fields, and the gate is not being shut properly allowing horses to barge it. AP has spoken to SCC to get swing gates put in place of the stile. Within the next week or so three new gates will be installed on the path. AP proposed we post a notice to walkers to observe the country code and encourage them to stick to the footpath. All councillors agreed.	AP
5.02:	The council had received a letter from a parishioner giving their views on the public participation document and also highlighting concern that old issues dating back to 2013 had not been brought to a conclusion. The two principal issues were the responsibilities and duties of the councillors which will be addressed when the new committee meet to decide who does what and the question of transparency at meetings which will be looked at along with the current legislation changes regarding this point coming into place in July 2015.  Other items in the letter were of a personal nature concerning previous councillors, which would not be responded to or discussed in line with the newly adopted Public Participation at Meetings document.

If the show should cease to continue both Norton and Chiselborough Parish Councils will take over the administration of any remaining funds, which will be held in trust for five years before distribution between the villages based on the head count on the electoral role. All councillors were happy with this proposal. KP will reply accordingly to the Show Secretary. 14: Fence around the Flood Alleviation Pool: RBR suggested we write to SCC to establish if there is a health and safety issue with the pool in the first instance that may require it to be fenced. 15: **Telephone Box Adoption and Website Poll:** A poll has been set up on the website to obtain parishioners views. So far there have been 29 responses to the poll. 25 people have said they would like to adopt the box. Paper copies are available if people wish to vote but do not have website access.
